<b>Attendance:</b> pupils have the right to education and parents have a legal responsibility to make sure children attend regularly.	Our Academy will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Contact parents on the first day of unknown absence</li> <li>Contact parents of children who regularly arrive late for the Academy day</li> <li>The Academy will only allow term time absence for recognised religious observance and bereavement</li> </ul>	Home will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Make every effort to make sure that their child will attend Academy every day and on time</li> <li>Inform the Academy as soon as possible about any absence and the reason for it</li> <li>Avoid taking children on holiday during term time</li> </ul>	Pupils will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Attend the Academy every day and arrive on time</li> </ul>
<b>Behaviour and Attitude:</b> pupils learn best in an orderly environment where everyone knows what is expected of them.	Our Academy will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Have a code of behaviour which creates a safe and caring environment for everyone</li> <li>Make sure that all staff, pupils and parents know what behaviour is expected</li> <li>Consistently implement the code of behaviour, sanctions and rewards</li> <li>Encourage staff and pupils to have a positive attitude to learning and caring</li> </ul>	Home will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Give praise at home for good behaviour and attitude at Academy</li> <li>Work with the Academy to find solutions in cases of unacceptable behaviour</li> <li>Ensure their child wears full Academy uniform <b>every day, which is clearly labelled.</b></li> <li>Ensure their child adheres to the uniform policy regarding hairstyles, footwear, swimming and PE kits and jewellery</li> </ul>	Pupils will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Keep the Academy and class rules</li> <li>Have a positive attitude to learning and the Academy</li> <li>*Adhere to the dress code and uniform policy including hairstyles, jewellery, footwear and blazers.</li> </ul>

Our Academy will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Keep parents informed about the home learning schedule</li> <li>Provide suitable materials and advice on home based activities and how to help</li> <li>Mark home learning promptly and give constructive feedback</li> </ul>	Home will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Encourage their child in home learning and sign the Academy diary every day</li> <li>Encourage their child to read every day</li> <li>Encourage their child to practise playing their musical instrument every day and commit to one academic year's tuition</li> </ul>	Pupils will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Complete all home learning set and return it to the Academy on time</li> <li>Read every day</li> <li>Practise every day if learning an instrument with the Academy</li> </ul>
<b>Communication:</b> good communication between home and the Academy is essential to make sure that pupils get the support they need.	Our Academy will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Be opening and welcoming at all times and offer opportunities for parents to be involved in Academy life</li> <li>Make sure that parents have information about their child's progress, behaviour and general Academy matters</li> <li>Make sure that parents are informed about what their child is learning and engage professional support as required</li> <li>Arrange for parents to discuss and set targets for their child</li> <li>Make sure they listen to parents concerns and do their best to help</li> </ul>	Home will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Tell the Academy about anything that may affect their child's learning or behaviour</li> <li>Attend parent evenings</li> <li>Raise concerns promptly and directly with the Academy</li> <li>Engage with professionals to seek expert advice in partnership with the Academy</li> </ul>	Pupils will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Take letters home, notes and reports from the Academy and give them to their parents</li> <li>Talk with parents and teachers about any worries at the Academy</li> </ul>
