Day 9	Discussion text: Write a list of advantages and disadvantages of taking the bus vs walking.	Comparing numbers and finding the difference: count all the forks and spoons in your kitchen. Day 10	Spellings revision: Practise all the spellings we have done so far this year	Time: Keep note of what time you wake up, have breakfast, have dinner, go to bed, every day.	Music: Teach your family the “hey hey look at me” song and come up with different actions.
